What makes this Pathway different?

- Level 3 MUST have 5 "9" to "4" including Maths/English at GCSE
- 3/4 Subjects similar or varied
- Theory learning / Classroom based
- Develops knowledge and academic skills
- Mostly exam with no more than 20% coursework (subject dependent)
- Exams taken at the end of the 2 years (A/S no longer a "halfway" qualification/ exam)
- Similar subjects to GCSE and a range of new subjects

Level 3 Diploma (Need 5 "9" to "4" at GCSE)

Level 2 Diploma (Need 4-5 grade"3" at GCSE)

Foundation Learning Level 1 (Need 4-5 grade"2" at GCSE)

Foundation Learning - Entry Level (No Quals needed)

- Practical learning
- Develops knowledge and work related skills
- Specific job / job related subjects
- Mostly coursework/ projects/ presentations
- Some subjects have a small exam element
- Classroom/ workshop/ workplace
- May include work experience

What makes this Pathway different?

Higher - Level 4 – 6
Alternative to F.T.
university to gain a degree
Need A-Levels or BTEC L3

Advanced - NVQ Level 3 (Need NVQ 2 or Level 2 Diploma)

Intermediate NVQ Level 2 (Need 4-3 at GCSE "3" / "4" or this ability.)

• 4 days a week in work/1 day a week in training OR a regular block release

- Training to do a **specific** job
- Learning in the workplace and also theory learning at training Includes Maths and English Functional Skills up to Level 2/ GCSE
- Paid minimum wage of £3.70 an hour

Apprenticeship

- Training to prepare for an apprenticeship if you don't have the grades/ experience to go straight into one
- Functional Skills Maths and English up to Level 1/2 and GCSE
- Work experience placement
- Level 1 vocational qualification
- Personal and employability skills and qualifications
- May be eligible for bursary, paid travel expenses, weekly payment or bonuses
